Beyond Brisbane Project 2020

Beyond Brisbane is an evangelistic and discipleship project run by ISM at the start of university calendar. This year the program was run from 9 to 21 of February. We had missionaries and students participating. Students were trained by our missionaries in evangelization and discipleship with Gospel materials and workshops.
